



USAFA Women 50-Year Art Exhibit Submission Agreement

Effective: July 10, 2025 | Version 1.0

This agreement outlines the terms and conditions for artists submitting work to the USAFA Women 50-Year Art Exhibits, which will be launched during the USAFA Women Celebration, April 23–26, 2026.

1. Copyright and Ownership - Artists affirm that they are the original creator and copyright holder of each submitted work, or have documented permission to submit derivative work. - Artists retain full copyright and ownership of all submitted pieces.

2. Usage License By submitting, artists grant USAFA Women a **non-exclusive, royalty-free license** to: - Display submitted artwork images in a digital gallery on the USAFA Women website - Present the artwork digitally at Arnold Hall, Polaris Hall, and Fairchild Hall during the celebration and extended exhibit - Print select pieces at 11" × 14" for temporary physical display at Arnold, Polaris, or Fairchild Hall. Use submitted images (with credit) in USAFA Women promotional materials, social media, press, and related publications.

This license is limited to exhibition and promotion of the USAFA Women 50-Year Celebration. USAFA Women will not sell, modify, or license artwork for unrelated uses without the artist's written consent.

3. Display and Credit - Artists will be credited wherever their work is displayed or published. Artist may include watermarking if desired for digital display.

4. Sales - USAFA Women does not sell artwork or manage transactions. - Artists may label their work as "For Sale" and provide contact information. - All sales are the sole responsibility of the artist and buyer. - If a sale results from exhibit visibility, a voluntary donation of 10% to USAFA Women is encouraged but not required.

5. Content Standards Submitted artwork must: - Be respectful and appropriate for public and academic display.

6. Liability Disclaimer USAFA Women is not liable for unauthorized use of images by third parties who may access the digital gallery or online promotions.

7. Legal Jurisdiction This agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Colorado, where the USAFA Women nonprofit is based.
